

OUR UNIQUE MISSION:

We are a progressive and inclusive interdenominational Christian community striving to cultivate a just & generous expression of faith, that is committed to being an anti-racist, LGBTQIA+ affirming, gender-equity-centered church.

OUR RESORATIVE VISION

We are working to repair the hurt that religious institutions have historically caused in the lives of people and overturn systems of oppression in the church and the wider world. It is our hope that we can set an example for a more inclusive and progressive expression of Christianity in the future by providing a place for people to deconstruct and reconstruct their faith in a space that celebrates queerness, invites questions, and treats all genders with equity and equality.

OUR UNITY IN VALUES

We embrace many different styles and expressions of worship and use different pronouns to refer to God. We value unity over uniformity because we are united by our shared values, and out of those come a variety of beliefs.

OUR DIVERSE LEADERSHIP

We are led through an equitable shared leadership model of co-pastors who represent both white, Black, and Hispanic ethnicities, straight, gay, and lesbian sexualities, male and female gender identities, disabled and able-bodied as well as age diversity that spans from thirties through fifties.

OUR PARTNERSHIPS & WORK

We partner with Greenpoint Reformed Church to serve meals to those who are hungry and with Judson Memorial Church and Ruth's Refuge to provide resources, food, shelter, and care to migrants seeking asylum in NYC. Most recently we partnered with Legal Aid to raise awareness and advocate for an end to forced labor in the New York State prison system.

TAX STATUS

We are an independent church that holds both non-profit and 501c3 status. And we are almost entirely funded by participants in our faith community.

WHY DO WE NEED YOUR HELP

Forefront church was mostly funded by a larger denomination at its founding, however, after the leaders of Forefront made a conscious decision to become an openly affirming and inclusive church, we lost all funding from the larger institution and we have relied on our congregants, as well as generous outside donors like yourself, who believe in the importance of our church.

Now 11 years since our founding,.Our church continues to grow, however, 70% of our congregation is between the ages of 20-30 years of age, which often means they don't have a lot of expendable income. This has required us to get creative with our funding by offering Benefit Concerts for the broader community and hosting auction gala events and grant applications.

Our church, like many small businesses, was also greatly affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. Giving from our congregation overall was deeply impacted because of population changes, economic losses, and inflationary increases.

This year our pastors took a 20% cut in pay because that's how much they believe in our mission!
