CONVERSATION GUIDE

Not before, or after it, but from it. Today, we want you to reflect on the whirlwinds in your own life. Where have you heard God speak to you? Where have you missed God's voice? How can you listen more carefully in the future? Is there a way that you can change your mind. or "repent" when it comes to your sensitivity to experiencing the presence of God?

Could that be true? If so, what do we do with that? What's that look like.

For some of us it means closing our bibles and sitting and just listening.

For others of us, it means to stop praying so much for what we want and to pray for the needs of another. For others of us it means to "look up" when we're walking around our city. To walk slower and to be on the lookout for those who are suffering, that we have the ability to relieve.
