WHY DO WE NEED TO KNOW IT?

The burden of proving ourselves is causing us to work ourselves to death. We don't rest because we are afraid of what we will lose if we do.

WHAT ARE WE GOING TO DO ABOUT IT?

Pick 12 hours a week to step completely away from your obligations to others, and do something that you truly delight in. Make that a consistent pattern in your life.

START HERE

CONVERSATION GUIDE

This week's message was geared towards helping us understand what we can learn from the rhythm of rest. Here are some key concepts to explore with the group.

Americans work too much

- Compared to other countries, Americans work longer, Americans are more likely to work nights, and Americans are more likely to work weekends
- 4 in 10 Americans leave vacation days unused
- 2/3 of respondents to the US Travel Association survey said their manager gave negative, mixed or no messages about taking paid time off
- nearly 1 in 4 U.S. workers have no vacation or paid time off; 4 in 10 do not earn paid sick days
- Of 23 countries, US leads most of the world in share of mothers who are working at 75% and share of overworked employees (more than 50 hours a week)
- At least 134 countries have laws setting the maximum length of the work week; the US does not
